

Registration Information:

All American Preschool is a 4-day a week program, meeting Monday through Thursday. The class is from 8:45 a.m. - 11:45 a.m.

Children must be 3 by September 1, 2011 and fully potty-trained in order to be enrolled.

Tuition is \$200.00 per month and includes gymnastic instruction. Payment is due by the 5th of each month.

Registration fee is \$50.00 per child, is non-refundable and due at time of registration.

There is a materials/supply fee of \$50.00 per child.

Class begins on Tuesday, September 6th, 2011 (after Labor Day) and the last class will be Thursday, May 24th, 2012.
